Pledge of Allegiance

Review and Acceptance of the 8 April Agenda. Motion to accept by Clerk Glasscock, second by Treasurer Lee; unanimous acceptance.

Review and Acceptance of the 11 March 2026 Board Minutes: Motion to accept by Trustee Theodorski, second by Treasurer Lee; unanimous acceptance. Supervisor Pfeiffer noted a typographical error; the business name of the accepted electric bid was misspelled. The minutes will be updated to correct this.

Review and Authorize Bill Payments: Motion to pay the bills as presented by Trustee Fischer, second by Treasurer Lee; unanimous acceptance.

Public Comment on the Agenda Items: None

Treasurer Report:

- CD Update CD \$174661.38. This will mature 7/3/2026
- Working on obtaining Mueller Township's initial EIN certification

Clerk Report:

- Website update. One proposal was received. The new owner of SineTech was contacted and a proposal was requested.
- A agreement for election services was signed with Schoolcraft County and coverage for an early voting schedule agreed on. Elections training is ongoing and the deputy clerk will also obtain training.

Trustee Report, Trustee Fisher:

- Nothing to report.

Trustee Report, Trustee Theodorski:

- It is noted that no Easter/spring events took place in the area this year. Would like to consider the township do something next year.
- Schoolcraft Veterans Association has an event on May 16.

Supervisor's Report:

- Wickwire Grant progress. Completed the latest progress report is due and filed a request for reimbursement for Wickwire invoice #6.
- Keur Electrical was notified they received the electrical update bid for the township hall.
- A new bank signature card is completed for State Savings Bank checking account.
- STC will provide a copy of their budget for our review to determine if we may provide support. This could involve a memorandum of understanding for marketing for Mueller Township.
- Two bids were received for a sign for the Mueller Township park renovation project.
- Discussion has taken place with the township's lawyer regarding the application process for a new retail store under Ordinance Number 19-420 regarding adult use marijuana. Detailed in New Business.

Road Commissioner's Report: Road Commissioner not in attendance. No report.

Sexton's Report: Supervisor Pheiffer reported. The position is still open. More research is needed on the topic of permitting pets to be buried with their owners. A new ordinance would be needed.

Assessor's Report: Assessor not in attendance. No report.

New Business:

- Treasurer Lee will coordinate the spring clean up.
- Supervisor Pheiffer made a statement in response to an application by Monique Leuquerique for a new retail store, Marijuanaland, LLC. The supervisor must exercise due diligence and has consulted township attorney Michael Bila. It is known that Monique Leuquerique is a defendant in a lawsuit currently in circuit court with the next action date of April 17. This application is tabled until the May township board meeting.

Old/Unfinished Business:

- Light at Boat Ramp – no updates
- Road Repairs – hold off road millage pending a determination of the dam assessment

Public Comment:

- Ryan Thierry commented about lawsuits involving Monique Leuquerique. He described the basis for the lawsuits and apologized for bringing certain people into the community.
- Howard Parmentier, Vice-Chair, Schoolcraft Memorial Hospital Board of Trustees. He is engaging with the communities and provided an overview of services. He would like to hear from the communities to determine their needs. SCMH is a 5013C non-profit employing more than 400 people. Their funding is reliant on payment for services and fundraising efforts. A first aid/cpr training will take place on June 4:00 – 7:30 pm available to the public. On August 13 basic life support, first aid and cpr training will be available to the public. The CFO is Robert Mott.
